hear of their travels.

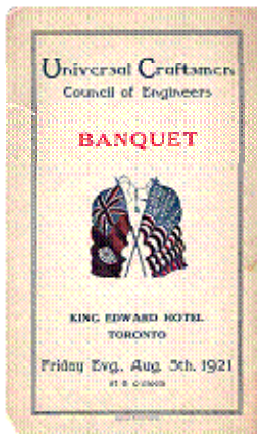
